Additionally, we celebrated the students reading well over 500 books with a pie throw at Mr. Allen and me. The kids had a blast and we had a tasty treat!






Dianne's Grade 6/7 Class




Robin's Bakwamkala Class


Gilakasda'xw'la

Even the big kids like to play with the toys!




Lyam's P.E. Class



The weather is getting warmer! Soup season is almost over! I will be adding some spring items to the menu in April. Any favourite food ideas are always welcome.






