There is a full-time upper intermediate teaching position being offered at Gwa'sala-'Nakwaxda'xw School for the 2026-2027 school year, starting on August 31, 2026. This is a one-year position with the possibility of continuation.

The Gwa'sala-'Nakwaxda'xw School is a band-operated independent school located in Port Hardy, British Columbia that enrolls 125 students from Preschool to Grade 7 (<https://www.gnschool.ca> or the Gwa'sala-'Nakwaxda'xw School on Facebook)

- Be willing to participate in cultural, school, and community events and learn from parents and community members
